SHALOM AUSTIN 2021 GRANTS - ROUND 2 FAQS

In 2021, the Shalom Austin Grants Committee decided to hold back a small percentage of available awards for a second round of applications. The hope is that organizations that were not operating due to COVID 19 limitations would be able to apply later in the year. We know you may have some questions and have tried to answer them below. Of course if you have additional questions don't hesitate to reach out.

What is the application criteria?

The criteria is the same as it is for our process in the winter but we will be prioritizing the following:

- Activities that would not have been possible in the height of the pandemic (such as in person activities) including the arts
- · Groups or organizations that did not previously apply in 2021 or receive grant awards
- Micro grants below \$2000
- · Groups impacting the Greater Austin area

If we already applied this year do we need to apply again?

• Yes. This round is for smaller grants (under \$2000) with an emphasis on new and/or impactful programs.

What is the application process?

- For Round two we have slimmed down the application and are asking for the following:
- A brief description of how the funds will be used to further Shalom Austin's mission of connecting and strengthening Jewish life in Austin and Central Texas.
- · Please be sure to include:
 - A description of how these funds will impact you in achieving your goals
 - · A description of who and how many people you estimate will benefit.

Grant Applicants may be asked to make a presentation about their request and answer questions the evening of August 25 via Zoom - please mark your calendar.

When is the application due?

• Please have all applications completed by August 18. The application can be found here.
